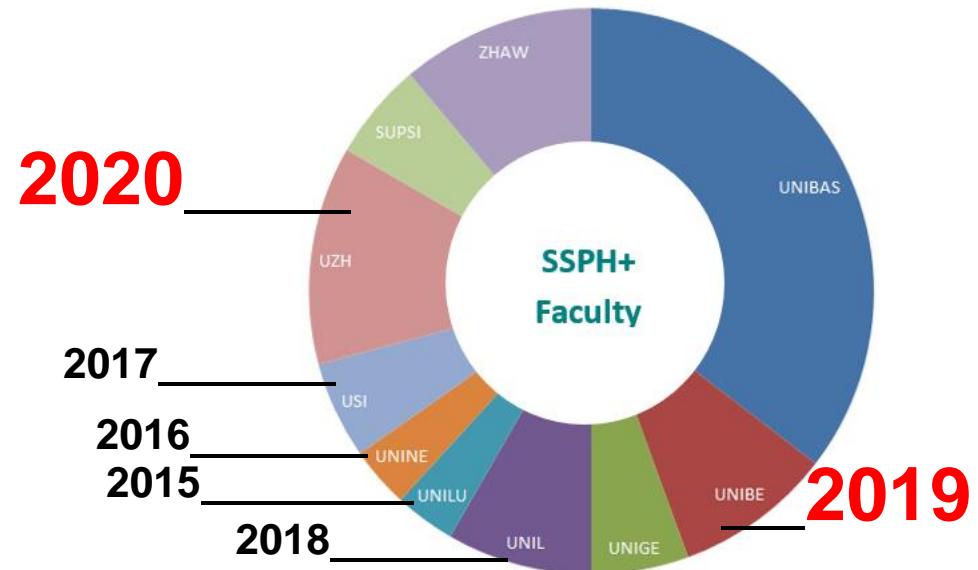

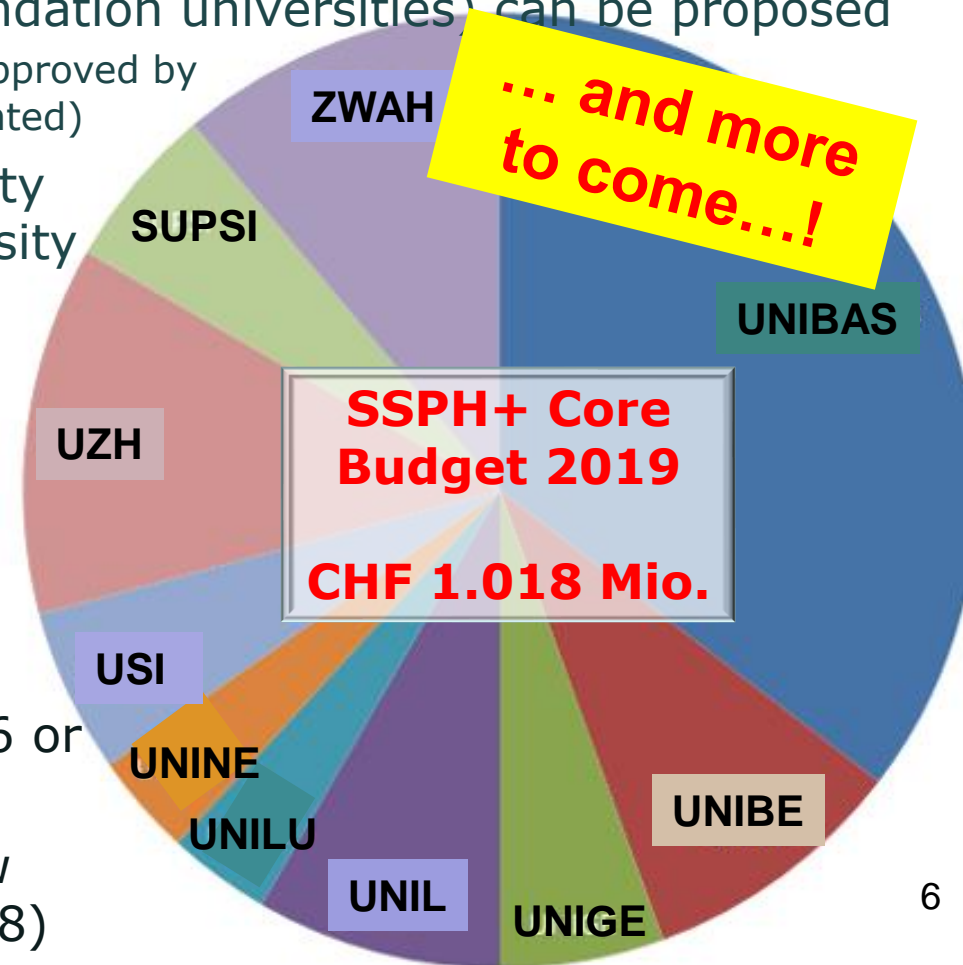

## 2... SSPH+ Expansion

1. Foundation Board agreed on the SSPH+ Expansion strategy under the vision:  
***ONE country – ONE inter-university, inter-disciplinary, inter-faculty Public Health Science faculty***
2. All faculty members (defined by the Foundation universities) can be proposed to become SSPH+ Faculty members (→ approved by Board if their research is public health sciences oriented)
3. Public health scientists who are not faculty member at one of the Foundation university or public health scientists from other Swiss institutions can be proposed as «SSPH+ Fellows»
4. Each SSPH+ Foundation university contributes to the annual CORE BUDGET of SSPH+
5. The contribution is based on the number of SSPH+ Faculty members (in Feb. 2016 or at time of joining SSPH+)
6. New members pay CHF 6'500/yr per new faculty member (see Annual Report 2018)



## SSPH+ GlobalP3HS Doctoral Program

- **SSPH+ Global PhD Program in Public Health Sciences brings CHF 5.436 Mio. to SSPH+ Faculty members (across 5 yrs), thus funds larger than the SSPH+ Core Budget!**
- Funded by MSCurie COFUND Actions (Horizon 2020)
- 50 PhD fellowships under supervision of an SSPH+ Faculty member
- “co-funding” (from supervisor) is REQUIRED → please sign contract only if you have found the right student and have ALL matching funds!
- Co-funds can be ALL SOURCES (including ESKAS stipend) except Horizon2020 funds
- **TWO PhD contracts possible**

(Special agreement with EU, confirmed as of 28.4.2019 – final signature pending!):

1. **“Default” Researcher:** employment contract identical to SNSF PhD salary (incl. social security, yr1 (CHF 3'920) to yr3-levels (CHF 4'170), etc.)
2. **“Sandwich Model” Researcher:** if a) collaboration partnership in LMIC (co-supervisor) AND b) student stays 4-6 months/yr in LMIC AND c) country of PhD student does NOT have social security agreement with Switzerland (almost all LMICs): “fixed stipend” of CHF 2'953 \*) (no social security.)

## The success story in numbers...

Marion Schulze

**Eligible AND top-ranked by international review panel** (score 8-10):

- **Call 1** (2 July – 12 October 2018): **64** out of 163 applicants
  - **Call 2** (3 December 2018 – 1 February 2019) **38** out of 70
  - **Call 3** open 1 April until **28 June 2019**
- ... make sure your top candidates apply in the 3rd call (e.g. those who just received an ESKAS stipend...!)
- **Only «top-ranked applicants» eligible to look for a (co-funding) supervisor.** This «matching process» stays open for all calls until 31.1.2020

## Inter-university Graduate Campus

### Guiding principles:

- Keep successes of current inter-university programs
- Give up administrative overload created by regulations, monitoring & controlling needs of parallel structures
- End segregation and parallel structures
- Expand activities with innovations in support of PhD research

### Characteristics:

- «**unrestricted inclusiveness**»: all 400+ PhD students supervised by SSPH+ faculty can register
- Strengthen academic content through attractive offerings
  - courses and networking events with SSPH+ faculty
  - support SSPH+ teaching faculty
  - awards, workshops, non-academic internships
- Provide «**recommendations**» and «**guidelines**» for quality PhD tracks in public health sciences (but no «mandatory regulations, thus, no tracking, controlling, reporting, monitoring etc.)
- Collaborate with local PhD programs and Graduate Schools to foster synergies

**NOTE:** the inter-university SSPH+ PhD Program in Public Health as the largest «core» of the future GC has now **CLOSED THE DOOR** for new applications  
→ Phasing-out until 2022

## 2.. Inter-university Graduate Campus

### Planning state and next steps:

- a) Backbone of GC is our new IT platform  
→ solution with ArtKey Media implemented May 2019 → test phase May 2019
- b) Election of Academic Board in June 2019
- c) «Official launch» of GC in August 2019

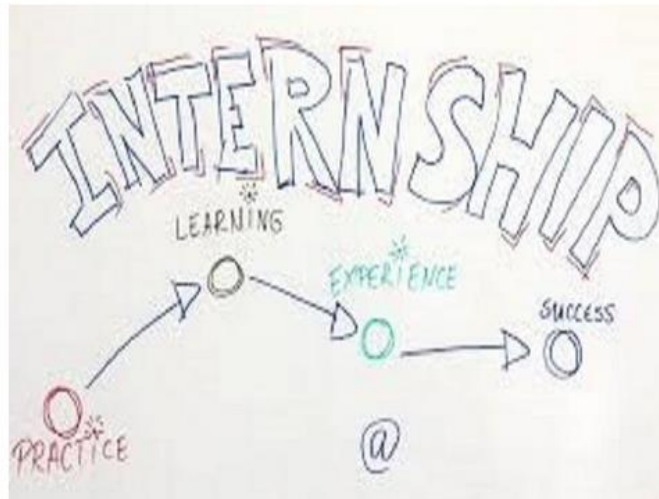

    - Preferred duration ~6 months, also «part-time»
